International Automotive Media Award for Lifetime Achievement

This award is presented to that individual who has been selected by his or her peers as contributing to the craft of automotive media for 25 years or more, breaking ground setting standards, and otherwise being a positive example to those who follow.

The 2004 recipient, Jerry Flint, who writes 'only' six columns a month now that he is "retired," joined the *Wall Street Journal* in Chicago in 1956. In 1958 he went to his birthplace, Detroit, for the

Journal. From '67-'73 he was with the *New York Times* as Detroit Bureau Chief and then with the *Times* in New York to 1979. In 1979 Jerry went with *Forbes*, serving as Washington D.C. Bureau chief until 1983, and then holding various titles in New York until his retirement in 1996.

Though best known for his automotive reporting, he has been called one of the top 100 financial writers of the 20th Century. That financial knowledge has served him and his readership well while proving disconcerting to the automakers at times. Not one to mince words, many in Detroit have felt the sting of Flint's insightful criticism, yet respect him for not playing favorites.

Jerry Flint has covered a diverse group of subjects over his career:

politics, economic news, race relations, crime, labor issues, Communism, even an airplane crash; as he says, "all the things a well-rounded journalist could cover in the last half of the 20th Century," — however, at this time we honor him for his outstanding accomplishments in reporting on the automobile.
